



David Smith St Ives Limited Deliver a Stunning Staircase for James Hall

Timber engineering specialists, David Smith St Ives Limited, were called upon to design and manufacture a bespoke staircase for installation at James Hall, a modern new office complex in St Ives, Cambridgeshire. The imposing 21,112 sq ft building is one of the largest speculative single office developments to be undertaken in the area, and its inspirational design and high quality specification has set a new benchmark for future commercial developments to aspire to.

Working with the property developers Lexitron Ltd, David Smith St Ives Limited developed an impressive half landing staircase that is situated as a focal point in the reception area and continues to span three floors. The staircase design is highly innovative as it features a mixture of beech timber and polished stainless steel, portraying a contemporary style that is synonymous with the interior finish specified throughout the building. The final design comprised of the handrails, treads and Landings being manufactured in German Beech, with the strings and balustrades in premium quality stainless steel.

Commenting on the staircase design, architect Mervyn Rossin said, "The specification of materials was critical in ensuring that each element reflected the aesthetic quality of the building. As the staircase is the prominent feature within the reception area, we obviously wanted the design to be unique and striking, and by working closely with the David Smith team we were able to achieve our objective".
